CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

<p>Primary (3 - 6 year olds) This 45 minute class teaches skipping, coordination, basic ballet steps, imagination, acting, and much more. Students focus on learning new movements and sharpening technique.</p>	<p>Level IA/IB (5 - 10 year olds) This hour class includes a syllabus and combinations with an occasional exercise in creativity. Class includes barre work and center work.</p>	<p>Level I This hour class meets once a week. Placement in this class is by experience. Students will learn more lengthened barre and center work and will focus on developing strong foundational technique.</p>	<p>Level II/III This hour class meets twice a week. Placement in this class is by experience. Students will learn more difficult combinations focusing on the correct technique of the steps. Pre-pointe is included in the class once a week.</p>	<p>Level IV This class meets three times a week. Placement in this class is by experience. Pointe and pre-pointe work is included with the regular class work. Students focus on sharpening ballet technique, knowledge and mental agility, and artistry.</p>
